1. You read that one of the main functions of the judiciary is 'upholding the law and enforcing Fundamental Rights'. Why do you think an independent judiciary is necessary to carry out this important function?

Ans. It is necessary to have an independent judiciary to carry out the basic function of "upholding the law and enforcing Fundamental Rights" because

- The independence of the judiciary is an integral part of democracy.
- It intends to shield the judicial process from external influences.
- To provide full legal protection to all individuals going to court for whatever reason.

Also, any citizen can approach the courts of law if his/her Fundamental Rights are violated, without fear of disputes being solved in favour of those in power.

2. How do you think the right to constitutional remedies connects to the idea of judicial review?

Ans. The Right to Constitutional Remedies connects to the idea of judicial review in its capacity of protecting the rights of an individual against the working of the State legislature or executive. The Right to Constitutional Remedies allows citizens to move the court if they think that any of their Fundamental Rights are being violated by the State administration. Judicial review implies invalidation of legislative or executive action if it is seen to violate Fundamental Rights. Hence, the Right to Constitutional Remedies and judicial review are inter-connected because the latter is practiced when a Fundamental Right is violated by the State. In this case, a higher court can repeal the judgments of a lower court based on its own investigation.
